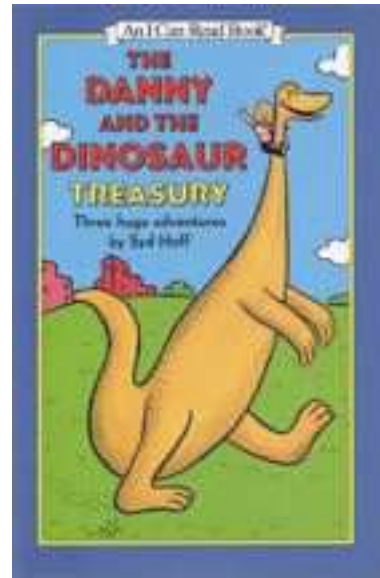
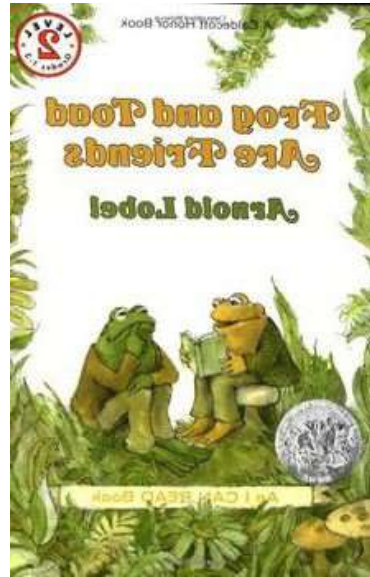
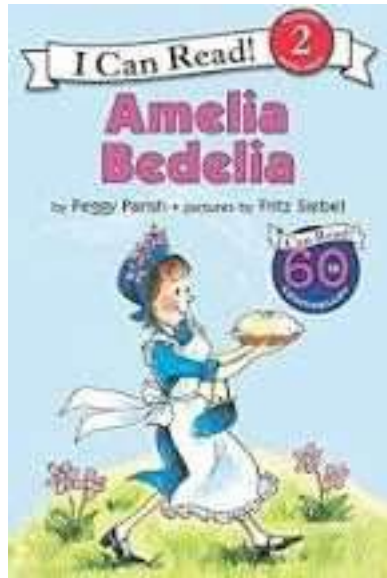

CE1 Framework

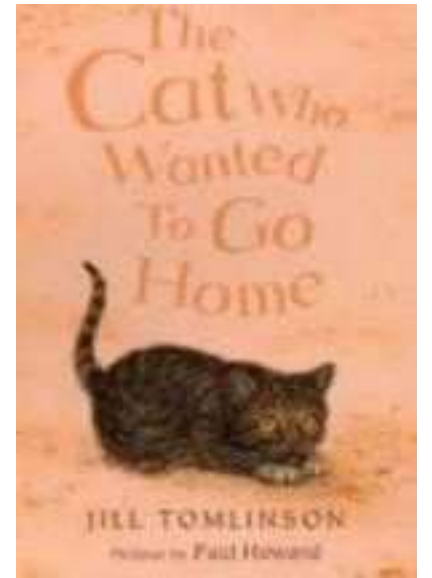
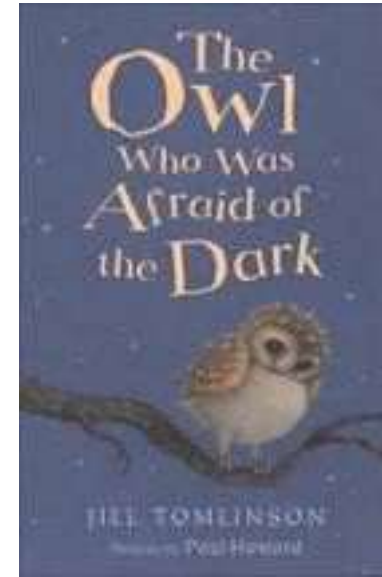
- Reading :

- Use phonic knowledge to decode new words.
- Read a wide range of common sight words.
- Pay attention to punctuation and begin to read with expression.
- Read fiction and non-fiction books and make appropriate comments and predictions based on a book.
- Begin to retrieve information and answer comprehension questions independently.
- Will have reached level 8 in Oxford reading series.
- Homework: Weekly Reading with Oxford Workbooks and Free Library Choice

Oxford Reading Series Fiction and Non-Fiction



Writing

- Use phonic knowledge to spell unknown words and begin to apply relevant spelling rules and patterns.
- Spell a wide range of common sight words correctly.
- Write correct grammatical sentences independently.
- Use a plan to begin writing a story.
- Write coherent stories with a beginning, middle and end.
- Begin to add more detail to descriptive writing.

- 1 Grammar/Spelling Homework Per Week

Oral

- Students should listen and respond to an increasing range and complexity of teacher instructions.
- Students should comment on characters and events of stories, draw conclusions and predict outcomes.
- Students should discuss topics in small groups and report back to the whole class.
- Activities include: Show and Tell, Role play, Puppets and Drama, Oral Reports on Specific Topic

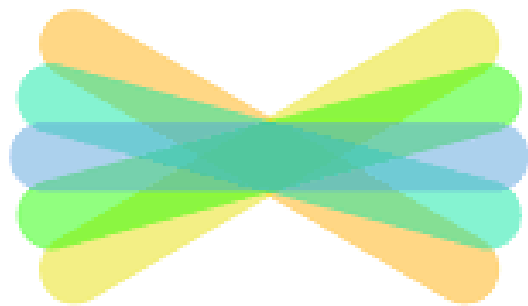
