READING FRAMEWORK

- By end of CE2 year, students should be independent readers. Students should be able to read with increasing fluency and begin to develop expression.
- Students should make use of appropriate information and reference books to retrieve information.
- Draw inferences about characters' thoughts and feelings.
- Understand the literary elements of character, setting and plot.
- Begin to understand style.

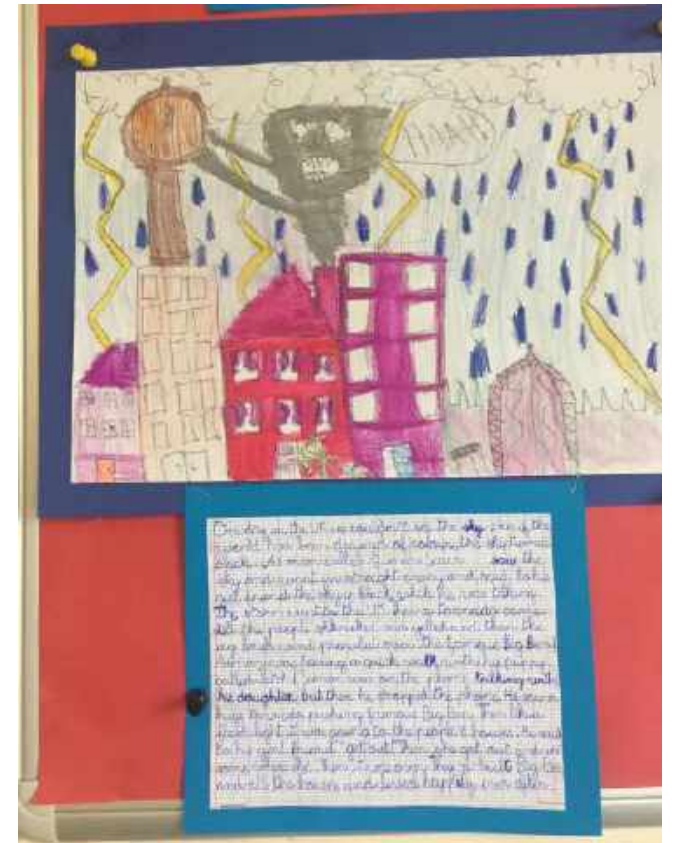

WRITING FRAMEWORK

- Begin to use paragraphs.
- Able to write different types of writing (instructional, persuasive, diary, letters, descriptive and topic reports)

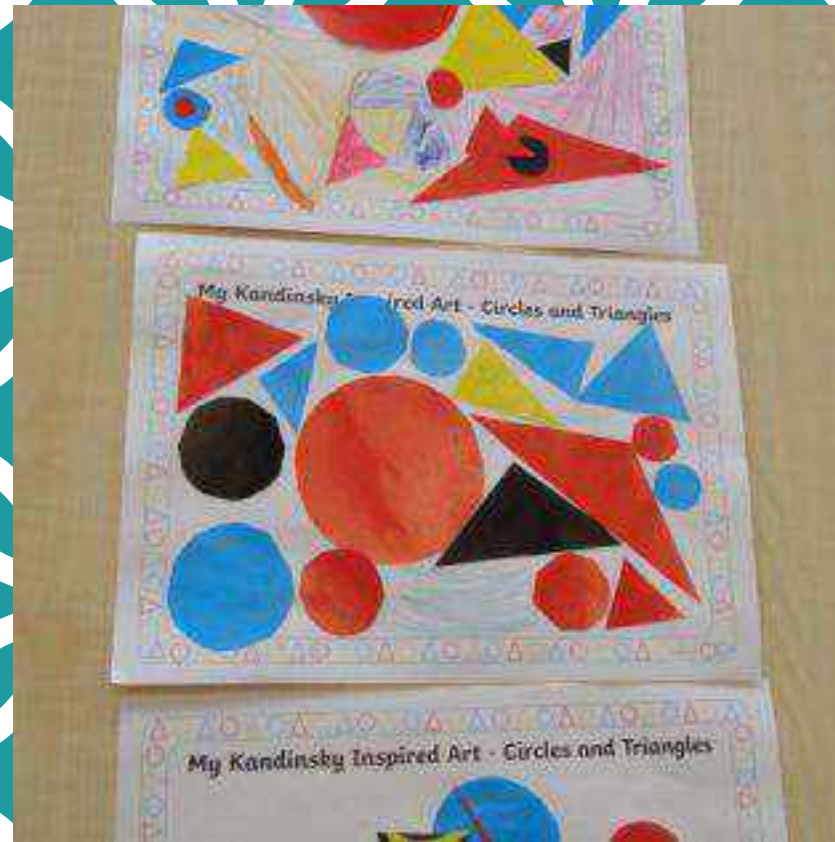
