CP Framework

-
- **Reading :**
 - Read common sight words.
 - Use phonic knowledge and attempt to decode words.
 - Use visual clues to assist in reading.
 - Make story predictions and is able to sequence events of a story.
 - Begin to understand the difference between fiction and non-fiction books.
 - By end of CP, all children will have reached Oxford reading series Level 5.

Writing

- Can spell common sight words. Weekly spelling words given to learn at home with spelling test in class.
- Can spell most cvc « short vowel » words.
- Make close attempts at spelling new words phonetically.
- Can construct a simple sentence independently using punctuation. (full stops and question marks)
- Can sequence sentences to construct a simple story (beginning, middle, end).
- Attempt different writing (descriptive sentence, factual sentence) and begin to extend ideas by adding adjectives.

Oral

- Can listen and follow instructions within a group.
- Can express themselves in clear, coherent sentences.
- Activities:
 - Show and Tell, Singing, Role Play, Retelling Stories, Puppet Shows
